You can get help and report the incident.

Reporting helps you get support for a specific incident. It also helps the government respond better to Islamophobia. If you can, report the incident to government services. If not, report where you feel comfortable.

Are in an emergency or life-threatening situation	» Call Triple Zero (000) immediately
Are not in immediate danger	» Report the incident to <ul style="list-style-type: none">• your local NSW Police station• or anonymously to Crime Stoppers 1800 333 000
Experience discrimination	» Contact Anti-Discrimination NSW 1800 670 812 complaintsadb@justice.nsw.gov.au
Experience online abuse or see harmful content	» Contact the e-Safety Commissioner esafety.gov.au/report
See damage to public property, including bus shelters and buildings	» Contact your local Council
